

Dear Parents and Guardians,

1. Driving inside Damai Primary School

Please be reminded that the speed limit within the school premises is 15km/h. For the safety of everyone, please exercise patience and look out for other road users.

To enhance safety within our school, we have established new crossing points and walkways along the parking lots. Below, you can find photographs of these locations along with a plan view for better understanding.



When dropping off or picking up your child, **please be reminded NOT to disembark from your vehicle** to avoid causing traffic disruptions.

2. Travel Declaration for September Holidays

With the September school holidays approaching, we would like to seek your cooperation to update and submit the travel declaration for your child/ward. **No action is required** if you have no intention to travel overseas during that period.

To make a travel declaration for your child/ward via Parents' Gateway (PG), go to [SERVICE > DECLARE TRAVELS]. Please declare your child/ward's travel plan(s), indicating both the country and city of travel, and any city of transit, by 29 August 2024 (Thursday). Only one parent is required to make the declaration.

If your child/ward is **not travelling** during the holidays, **no action is required**.

3. Preparations for Assessments and Examinations

As our students intensify their preparations for assessments and examinations, we kindly ask for your assistance in ensuring your child is well-rested, receives adequate sleep, and is mentally and emotionally prepared for school.

4. PSLE Oral Examination

PSLE Oral Examination will be held on **13 & 14 August 2024 (Tuesday & Wednesday)**. Primary 1 to 5 students need not attend school on these two days. Primary 6 students will receive further instructions on their reporting time for the examination.

5. PSLE Listening Comprehension Examination

PSLE Listening Comprehension will be held on **Friday**, **13 September 2024**. Primary 1 to 5 students need not attend school on this day. Primary 6 students will receive further instructions on their reporting time for the examination.

6. Primary 6 Preliminary Examination

The Primary 6 Preliminary Examination will be conducted from **15 August to 21 August 2024 (Thursday to Wednesday).** The detailed examination schedule with the list of examination topics and components to be assessed has been sent to all Primary 6 parents.

7. Primary 3 Gifted Education Programme (GEP) Screening Exercise 2024

The Gifted Education Programme Screening Exercise will be conducted on **Thursday**, **15 August 2024**. It will be based on what the students have learnt from the Primary 1 to Primary 3 English Language and Mathematics syllabuses. Details of the GEP Screening Exercise have been sent to parents of students in Primary 3.

9. National Day Celebration on 8 August

Please make the necessary transport arrangements for your child. The school bus operator has been notified of the early dismissal hours. Students attending student care will proceed to the Student Care Centre upon dismissal. Parents are advised to confirm their arrangements with the bus operator or student care operator.

Students are encouraged to wear a red t-shirt for the celebration if they have one readily available at home. It is not necessary to purchase a red t-shirt specifically for the occasion; your child can also wear their PE attire.

13. Holistic Assessment Portfolio

During the last week of Term 3, students will receive their Holistic Assessment Portfolio. Please review and endorse your child's reflection form and progress card included in the Portfolio. Students should keep the Portfolio and use the holistic assessment papers/weighted assessment papers filed within to revise for the upcoming End-Year Examination. There is no need to return the Portfolio to the form teachers when students return to school after the term break.

14. Edusave Award for Achievement, Good Leadership & Service (EAGLES)

The Edusave Award for Achievement, Good Leadership & Service (EAGLES) was introduced in 2001 to recognise students' leadership qualities, excellence in non-academic activities, and service to community and schools. This yearly award is open to students who are Singapore Citizens.

With effect from 2024, EAGLES is enhanced to recognise students with consistent and exemplary demonstration of Emerging 21st Century Competencies (E21CC) in government/government-aided primary and secondary schools, independent schools, specialised independent schools, and junior colleges/Millennia Institute (JC/MI). This is part of the larger goal to prepare our students to thrive in a fast-changing, complex and inter-connected world, by encouraging the development and application of future-ready competencies. The enhancement will see Primary 1 to 3 Singapore Citizens students, in addition to Primary 4 to 6 Singapore Citizens students, eligible for EAGLES in E21CC.

EAGLES is given out at the community level, together with the Edusave Scholarship, Edusave Merit Bursary, Edusave Good Progress Award, Edusave Character Award, and Edusave Skills Award.

15. Bringing of Chewing Gum to School

We would like to remind parents that students are prohibited from bringing chewing gum to school. Students found with chewing gum, whether for personal consumption or to share with peers, will face disciplinary action that will affect their conduct grade.
